EBSCOhost 2.0 includes several exciting new features for viewing your search results.

Result List Features:

- **Article Preview:** EBSCOhost 2.0 allows you to preview an article's citation by holding the pointer over the preview icon located next to the article's title.

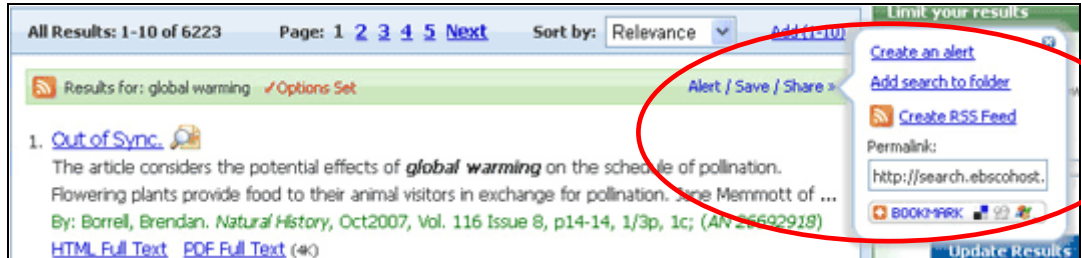

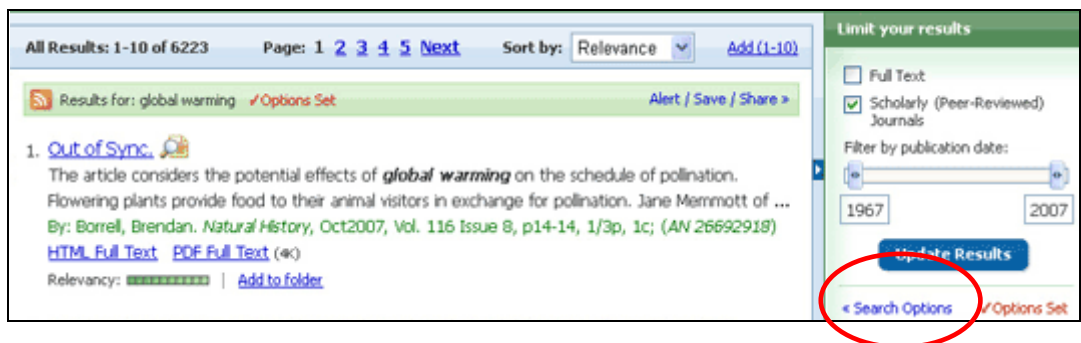

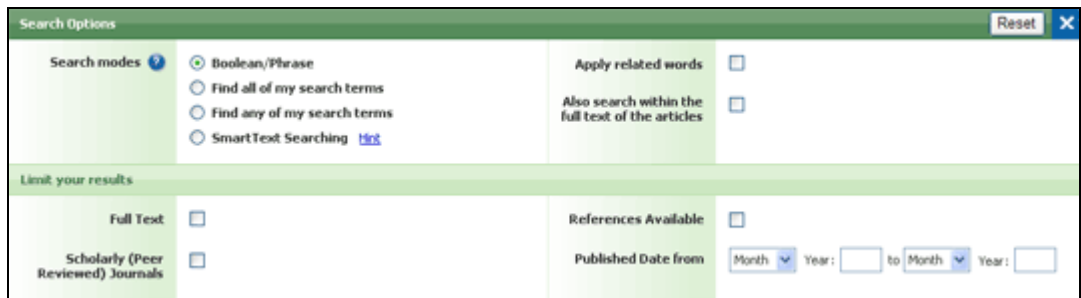


Limit Your Results area:
