B. President's Report

We have seen an increase in spring enrollment. Our latest report shows us up over 9.7% in credit and 11.1% for a headcount of 5,956. Our next 8-week session begins March 18.

We are one of only four Illinois community colleges in the state chosen to share in a \$3 million Department of Energy grant to develop more green energy jobs. We will be using funds to help meet the needs of local manufacturers by providing mobile training equipment to expand availability of LLCC's industrial maintenance certificate at Outreach Centers.

We welcomed the first cohort of 17 Illinois DoIT (Department of Innovation & Technology) trainees to an orientation on January 17. We are partnering with DoIT to provide a paid trainee program to build a pipeline of tech talent. We also have a training partnership with the Illinois Department of Revenue underway this semester.

LLCC Star Dusters, a team of students from a biology class at our Litchfield Outreach Center, recently won the Best in Show Innovation Award at the Plant the Moon/Mars Competition through the Institute of Competition Sciences. The competition featured teams researching, developing, and testing innovative ways to grow crops on Mars. The team was given Martian soil simulant and had eight weeks to grow their crop (radish microgreens) in an innovative way. The team found additives that may enhance the water retention of the Martian soil to better penetrate plant roots.

LLCC's Livestock Judging Team recently placed third overall and first in the sheep/goats competition at the National Western Stock Show in Denver.

Karen Sanders, vice president, advancement, and executive director of the LLCC Foundation, received the 2023 Agricultural Education Advocacy Award at the annual meeting of the Illinois Leadership Council for Agriculture Education. She received the award for her tireless efforts to promote agriculture education at LLCC and throughout central Illinois.

Two of our nursing faculty members — Casey Hoenes and Joi Kazenski — have been awarded \$10,000 Nursing Educator Fellowship Grants from the Illinois Board of Higher Education. Hoenes is currently pursuing a doctorate in nursing education. Kazenski earned a doctorate in 2020. The fellowships are awarded to “help retain well-qualified nursing faculty at institutions of higher education that award degrees that lead to a registered nurse licensure.” This is the second pair of LLCC nursing faculty to receive this award. Leslie Catalano and Bridgette Hudson received the award in 2023.

Bistro Verde will be opening this Wednesday, January 31, with Bistro To Go. It will be open Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays, 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. through February 29. The full-service lunch will run March 27 through April 18, again Tuesdays through Thursdays.

Welcoming students back to campus for the spring semester — Student Life held activities including service projects, vision setting, an escape room and fun snacks.

Jacksonville hosted a community scholarship and FAFSA event last week (January 24) with 41 student attendees and 19 community exhibits. A FAFSA event is also being held in Taylorville this Wednesday.

A blood drive was held on campus last week.

Education and activities have been provided on Stalking Awareness Month for students and employees.

Today our Writing Center was set up in the Workforce Careers Center lobby to offer free onsite help with scholarship personal essays. The Foundation Scholarship application period is open through February.


