**Introduction**

As part of an ongoing accountability and program improvement initiative, Lincoln Land Community College annually conducts a survey of occupational program graduates. This report provides information on graduates of occupational programs regarding the effectiveness of their community college experiences. Graduates are asked to complete a standardized survey instrument that addresses attendance objective, education status, employment status, salary, employment start-up, geographic location of employment, and satisfaction with employment and components of the educational program completed. Data gathered from these surveys provide valuable information for the College's program review process and assists the college in providing satisfactory employment and compensation for their graduates.

The Illinois Community College Board identifies the programs that must be included at each local campus. For the fiscal year 2004 study, twenty-four occupational programs were identified. Of these twenty-four programs, Lincoln Land Community College offers degrees in the following: Agri-Business Management, Landscape Design/Turf Management, Associate Degree Nursing, Practical Nurse, Basic Nurse Assisting, and Construction Occupations. Lincoln Land Community College elected to include all occupational programs in the follow-up survey. Former students who completed occupational programs during fiscal year 2003 (summer term 2002, fall term 2002, or spring term 2003) were mailed surveys. This year, the Office of Planning and Institutional Research also utilized e-mail addresses on file for former students. An email was sent to students with an e-mail address on file, instructing the student to visit the Planning and Research web site to take the survey online. If a graduate did not respond to the initial questionnaire or e-mail, a second survey was forwarded. If the second contact with these students did not elicit a response, LLCC Workplace Learning staff and department chairs attempted to contact the graduate by phone. There were nearly three hundred graduates contacted by phone.

A total of 1,067 LLCC former students were surveyed in March 2004. The first mailing elicited 199 responses by mail. Fifty-nine students took advantage of the online survey, accounting for nearly fourteen percent of the responses received. Overall, four hundred thirty-three persons responded, yielding a response rate of 40.58 percent. As illustrated in Table 1, the Basic Nurse Assisting program accounted for the largest group of the graduates responding. Because overall results are influenced by program size, the data reported in Tables 1 - 21 are provided by program category. Table totals will vary due to some respondents failing to answer all survey questions.
