



**FISCAL YEAR 2006  
CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION FOLLOW-UP STUDY  
OF FISCAL YEAR 2005 GRADUATES**

**LINCOLN LAND COMMUNITY COLLEGE  
August, 2006**

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**Introduction**

As part of an ongoing accountability and program improvement initiative, Lincoln Land Community College annually conducts a survey of occupational program graduates. This report provides information on graduates of occupational programs regarding the effectiveness of their community college experiences. Graduates are asked to complete a standardized survey instrument that addresses attendance objective, education status, employment status, salary, employment start-up, geographic location of employment, and satisfaction with employment and components of the educational program completed. Data gathered from these surveys provide valuable information for the College's program review process and assists the College in providing satisfactory employment and compensation for their graduates.

The Illinois Community College Board identifies the programs that must be included at each local campus. For the fiscal year 2006 study, sixteen occupational programs were identified. Of these sixteen programs, Lincoln Land Community College offered and awarded degrees during fiscal year 2005 in the following: Word Processing and Graphics Specialist, Computer Programming, Criminal Justice Studies, Networking Administration, Networking Technician, Help Desk Level I & II, Microcomputer Programming, Law Enforcement, Community Police Officer, Medical Transcription, Social & Criminal Justice, Applied Security Practices, Electronics Technology, Computer Technician Specialist, Electrical Distribution Lineman Maintenance, and Commercial Electrical Maintenance. Lincoln Land Community College elected to include all occupational programs in the follow-up survey. Former students who completed occupational programs during fiscal year 2005 (summer term 2004, fall term 2004, or spring term 2005) were mailed surveys. If a graduate did not respond to the initial questionnaire, a second survey was forwarded. If the second contact with these students did not elicit a response, LLCC staff attempted to contact the graduate by phone.

A total of 998 LLCC former students were surveyed in March 2006. Four hundred nine persons responded, yielding a response rate of 40.98 percent. Graduates from the programs that ICCB identified as required for fiscal year 2005 accounted for 255 of the surveyed graduates and 102 of the responses, yielding a response rate of 40.0 percent. As illustrated in Table 1, the Basic Nurse Assistant program accounted for the largest group of the graduates responding. Because overall results are influenced by program size, the data reported in Tables 1 - 18 are provided by program category. Table totals will vary due to some respondents failing to answer all survey questions.
